Vowel digraphs

💡 This includes double vowels like the long “oo” in “moon” or short “oo” in “foot”. Other vowel digraphs are formed by two different vowels like “ai” in “rain” or “oa” in “boat”.

💡 A long vowel sound is usually formed in a vowel digraph. As mentioned above, this rule is simply put as “***when two vowels go walking, the first one does the talking.***”
